TRAVEL AND MEALS FOR MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS
Travel Expenses (less than 40 km) - travel expenses cannot be claimed as a medical expense if you traveled less than 40 km's (one way) from your home to get medical services
Travel Expenses(at least 40 km) - the cost of public transportation expenses are eligible (ie; taxis, buses, trains) or vehicle expenses when a person needs to travel at least 40 km one way, but less than 80km, from their home to get medical services if services are within reason and not available closer
Travel Expenses (at least 80 km) - the cost of the travel expenses, including accomodations, meals, and parking, are eligible when a person needs to travel at least 80 km one way from their home to get medical services if services are within reason and not available closer
